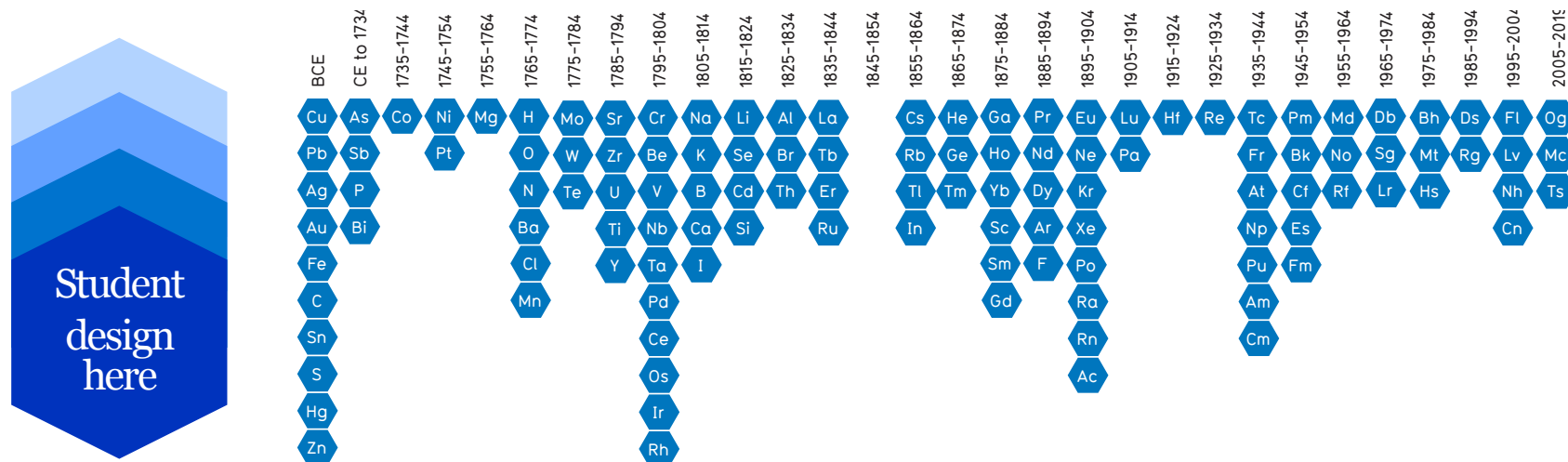


2019 International Year of the Periodic Table

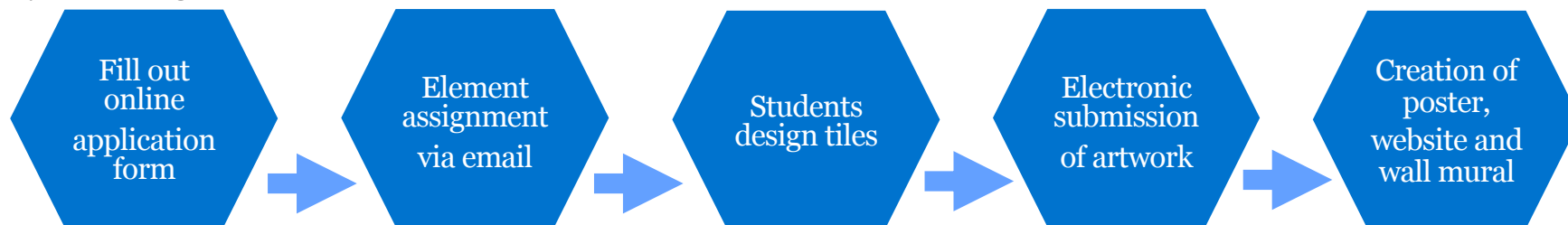
